## AN ACT

To repeal section 290.505, RSMo 2000, relating to overtime compensation of employees, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 290.505, RSMo 2000, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu  
2 thereof, to be known as section 290.505, to read as follows:

290.505. [1.] No employer shall employ any of his **or her** employees for a workweek  
2 longer than forty hours unless such employee receives compensation for his **or her** employment  
3 in excess of the hours above specified at a rate not less than one and one-half times the regular  
4 rate at which he **or she** is employed.

5 [2. Employees of an amusement or recreation business that meets the criteria set out in  
6 29 USC 213(a)(3) must be paid one and one-half times their regular compensation for any hours  
7 worked in excess of fifty-two hours in any one-week period.]

**EXPLANATION** — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
