AN ACT

To amend chapter 263, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to noxious weeds.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 263, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 263.232, to read as follows:

2 **263.232. It shall be the duty of any person or persons, association of persons,**
2 **corporations, partnerships, the state highways and transportation commission, any state**
3 **department, any state agency, the county commissions, the township boards, school boards,**
4 **drainage boards, the governing bodies of incorporated cities, railroad companies and other**
5 **transportation companies or their authorized agents and those supervising state-owned**
6 **lands to control the spread of and to eradicate by methods approved by the state**
7 **department of agriculture cut-leaved teasel (*Dipsacus laciniatus*), common teasel (*Dipsacus***
8 **fullonum) and kudzu vine (*Pueraria lobata*) which are hereby designated as noxious and**
9 **dangerous weeds to agriculture.**
