### AN ACT

To amend chapter 43, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to compensatory time for members of the highway patrol.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 43, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 43.072, to read as follows:

3 **43.072. Any member of the patrol, as defined in section 43.010, who works more**  
4 **than one hundred sixty hours in any twenty-eight-day pay period shall, at such member's**  
5 **option, receive either compensation time equal to the amount of time worked in excess of**  
6 **one hundred sixty hours, or shall receive pay at that member's regular rate for the amount**  
7 **of time worked in excess of one hundred sixty hours. The member shall exercise this option**  
**before the end of the twenty-eight-day pay period immediately subsequent to the twenty-**  
**eight-day pay period in which the compensation time or pay accrued.**
