

House Resolution No.

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives enjoy a long, proud tradition of meeting their responsibilities to the citizens of this state while upholding the virtues represented by the "Glory of Missouri": Knowledge, Liberty, Equality, Law, Justice, Fraternity, Education, Progress, Honor, Truth, Virtue, Temperance, Enterprise, and Charity; and

Whereas, the "Glory of Missouri" virtues were engraved in the House Chamber of the State Capitol in the early 1920s under the direction of the Decorating Commission with the inscription: "All the foregoing human qualities bind into one theme, the Glory of Missouri because no people attain these virtues unless they are great."; and

Whereas, the "Glory of Missouri" Award was created to encourage the values held by the early leaders of Missouri and to recognize those standards as exemplified in our schools and communities by this state's young people who are the future of Missouri; and

Whereas, Brandon Hunter, a student at Rockwood South Middle School in Fenton, has been selected to receive the "Glory of Missouri" Award for his accomplishments in the area of FRATERNITY as defined by the intent of the Decorating Commission for the Capitol in 1922: "Fraternity is friendliness. The tendency of human-kind is to mix socially, according to the Missouri Legislature of 1922."; and

Whereas, the son of Bruce and Mary Jo Hunter, Brandon is a humble, talented individual with a keen sense of leadership who attracts students by his friendly personality and his sincere desire to excel in all of his academic pursuits; and

Whereas, Brandon finds an incredible amount of energy to involve himself fully in the National Junior Honor Society, Rockwood South school plays, Symphonic Band, Concert Choir, baseball, basketball, Church Orchestra, and Church Youth Group:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-first General Assembly, join unanimously in commending Brandon Hunter for his noteworthy achievements in the pursuit of FRATERNITY and in congratulating him at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Brandon Hunter, as a mark of our esteem for him.
