

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives enjoy a long, proud tradition of meeting their responsibilities to the citizens of this state while upholding the virtues represented by the "Glory of Missouri": Knowledge, Liberty, Equality, Law, Justice, Fraternity, Education, Progress, Honor, Truth, Virtue, Temperance, Enterprise, and Charity; and

Whereas, the "Glory of Missouri" virtues were engraved in the House Chamber of the State Capitol in the early 1920s under the direction of the Decorating Commission with the inscription: "All the foregoing human qualities bind into one theme, the Glory of Missouri because no people attain these virtues unless they are great."; and

Whereas, the "Glory of Missouri" Award was created to encourage the values held by the early leaders of Missouri and to recognize those standards as exemplified in our schools and communities by this state's young people who are the future of Missouri; and

Whereas, Daniel P. Lutz, a student at Rockwood South Middle School in Fenton, has been selected to receive a "Glory of Missouri" Award for his accomplishments in the area of TRUTH as defined by the intent of the Decorating Commission for the Capitol in 1922: "A reflection of every line with strict accuracy" is the way the early Legislature thought of truth. They wrote, "The truth is never complete if only a part of the facts are revealed; in fact, the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth is the Naked Truth."; and

Whereas, the son of Jim and Davonna Lutz, Daniel is an honest, trustworthy young man who serves as a role model for his peers by setting high standards for himself and working diligently to achieve only the best in all that he pursues; and

Whereas, Daniel strives for excellence regardless of the nature of his pursuit and succeeds to a remarkable degree as a member of the National Junior Honor Society or as a participant in soccer, hockey, baseball, and football:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-first General Assembly, join unanimously in commending Daniel P. Lutz for his noteworthy achievements in the pursuit of TRUTH and in congratulating him at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction:
