

House Resolution No. 910

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives take tremendous pleasure in acknowledging milestone events in the lives and careers of Show-Me State residents who have steadfastly and diligently proven to be exemplary citizens in their local communities and neighborhoods; and

Whereas, June Pierce is one of the visionary founders of what is now known as the Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Platte County, Missouri, for which he had served as President of the Board of Directors, Plant Operator, Meter Reader, and Inspector and in numerous other capacities before his retirement on December 31, 2001; and

Whereas, established in 1964 as a Federal Financed Water District to serve the Waldron community, the Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Platte County, Missouri, formed after the Flood of 1993 to unite the water supplies of the Waldron and Farley towns by installing a water main along Highway 45, under the Platte River, and to the Farley water treatment plant; and

Whereas, starting with one water well and a treatment plant, the Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Platte County, Missouri, has undergone numerous improvements down through the years under the astute supervision of June Pierce, including the drilling of more wells, the raising of two elevated storage tanks, and the running of a sixteen-inch water transmission main to connect with Kansas City Water which now serves as the sole water supplier; and

Whereas, tying in with the Kansas City water supply in 1998 illustrated leakage problems with the nearly four-decades-old Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 infrastructure, issues which were handily addressed and corrected under the direction of June Pierce before his retirement:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-first General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the stellar career and impressive, service-oriented life of June Pierce and to convey to him this legislative body's heartiest congratulations upon his well-deserved retirement from the Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Platte County, Missouri, and our best wishes for continued personal success for many more years to come; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution to honor the December 31, 2001, retirement of June Pierce.
