AN ACT

To appropriate money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the Department of Mental Health, the Board of Public Buildings, the Department of Health and Senior Services, and the several divisions and programs thereof, the Missouri Health Facilities Review Committee and the Commission for the Senior Rx Program to be expended only as provided in Article IV, Section 28 of the Constitution of Missouri, for the period beginning July 1, 2002 and ending June 30, 2003.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, to be expended only as provided in

150 preconception counseling, education, and general reproductive
151 health care. Follow-up services are services that supplement initial
152 consultations for family planning services and pregnancy testing
153 but do not include pregnancy or childbirth care. Nondirective
154 counseling is defined as providing patients with a list of health
155 care and social service providers that provide pregnancy, prenatal,
156 delivery, infant care, foster care, adoption, alternative to abortion
157 and abortion services and nondirective, non-marketing information
158 in regard to such providers. Such list may categorize the providers
159 by the service or services they provide. The department and any
160 other government entity receiving funds pursuant to this subsection
161 may not directly refer patients who seek abortion services to any
162 organization that provides abortion services. Nondirective
163 counseling relating to pregnancy may be provided. None of the
164 funds provided pursuant to this subsection may be paid or granted
165 to a government entity that provides abortion services. The
166 department and any other government entity receiving funds
167 pursuant to this subsection may not display or distribute marketing
168 materials about abortion services to patients. An independent
169 audit shall be conducted at least once every three years to ensure
170 compliance with this section. The audit shall be conducted by
171 either an independent auditing firm retained by the Department of
172 Health or by an independent auditing firm approved by the
173 department and retained by the government entity receiving these
174 funds. Any government entity receiving federal funds pursuant to
175 Title X of the federal Public Health Services Act may perform
176 services which are required under the federal act, but otherwise
177 prohibited pursuant to this section if:

- 178 1) Specifically directed by the United States Secretary of Health
