AN ACT

To amend chapter 565, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to enticement of a child, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 565, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 565.151, to read as follows:

3 **565.151. 1. A person commits the crime of enticement of a child if that person, for**
4 **the purpose of engaging in lewd, illicit, or criminal conduct with a child, attempts to**
5 **persuade or persuades whether by words or actions or both, any person who is less than**
6 **fourteen years of age to enter a vehicle, building, structure, alley, or any other enclosed**
7 **area so that the child is concealed from public view.**

8 **2. Nothing contained in this section shall prevent the lawful detention of a child or**
9 **the rendering of aid or assistance to a child.**

10 **3. Enticement of a child is a class D felony.**
