## AN ACT

To amend chapter 198, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the employment of food services directors in facilities licensed by the division of aging.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 198, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 198.034, to read as follows:

2 **198.034. 1. All facilities defined in section 198.006 and all adult day care programs**  
3 **established pursuant to section 660.400, RSMo, that are licensed by the division of aging**  
4 **and provide food services shall employ a food services director who is certified in food**  
5 **safety by an accredited program, and who is a certified dietary manager (CDM) or a**  
6 **registered dietician (RD).**

7 **2. All long-term care facilities licensed by the division of aging shall, at a minimum,**  
8 **employ a registered dietician on a consulting basis to perform a minimum of eight hours**  
9 **of dietary consultation in the facility each month. Any work performed by the registered**  
10 **dietician outside of the facility shall not count towards the eight-hour minimum**  
**requirement.**
