## AN ACT

To amend chapter 566, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to child luring, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 566, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 566.150, to read as follows:

3 **566.150. 1. A person commits the crime of child luring if that person entices or**  
4 **attempts to entice a child under the age of seventeen years to enter a motor vehicle,**  
5 **dwelling, or building, or to meet the person at a specific location, with the intent of**  
6 **engaging in any act prohibited by this chapter, chapter 565, RSMo, or chapter 568, RSMo.**

7 **2. Child luring is a class D felony.**
