AN ACT

To repeal section 571.030, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to concealable weapons, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 571.030, RSMo 2000, is repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 50.535, 571.030 and 571.094, to read as follows:

2 **50.535. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 50.525 to 50.745 the fee**
3 **collected pursuant to subsection 7 of section 571.090, RSMo, or subsection 13, 14, 20, 21**
4 **or 22 of section 571.094, RSMo, shall be deposited by the county treasurer into a separate**
5 **interest-bearing fund to be known as the county sheriff's revolving fund to be expended**
6 **at the direction of the sheriff as provided in this section.**

7 **2. Prior approval of the expenditures from this fund shall not be required by the**
8 **governing body of the county or a city not within a county, nor shall any prior audit or**
9 **encumbrance of the fund be required before any expenditure is made by the sheriff from**
10 **this fund. This fund may be audited by the state auditor's office or the appropriate**
11 **auditing agency.**

12 **3. No prior approval of the expenditures from this fund shall be required by the**
13 **governing body of the county or city not within a county, nor shall any prior audit or**
14 **encumbrance of the fund be required before any expenditure is made by the sheriff from**
 this fund. This fund may be audited by the state auditor's office or the appropriate
