## AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the designation of the Henry Shaw Ozark Corridor.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 227.323, to read as follows:

2 **227.323. 1. The portion of interstate highway 44, log mile 277.3, Geyer Road**  
3 **overpass, located in a county of the first classification with a charter form of government**  
4 **and with more than one million inhabitants, to log mile 255.0, one mile west of Gray**  
5 **Summit interchange, located in a county of the first classification without a charter form**  
6 **of government and with more than ninety-three thousand eight hundred but less than**

7 **2. Pursuant to section 226.525, RSMo, appropriate signage will be provided at the**  
8 **east and west boundaries of the Henry Shaw Ozark Corridor. Such signage shall affirm**  
9 **the state's value for its natural heritage, the Ozarks, plus the cultural heritage of the**  
10 **communities located along the Henry Shaw Ozark Corridor.**
