AN ACT

To repeal section 517.111, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to practice and procedure in civil cases originally filed before associate circuit judges.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 517.111, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 517.111, to read as follows:

517.111. [1.] When a case is dismissed, or judgment is by default or consent, such
2 judgment shall be entered forthwith by the judge.

3 [2. When a case is tried before a judge without a jury, judgment shall be entered by the
4 judge within thirty days after the case is submitted for final decision unless the parties consent
5 to a longer period of time.]

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
