AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to special license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 301.3107, to read as follows:

301.3107. 1. Any member of Missouri Task Force One may receive special license
2 plates as prescribed by this section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely
3 or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed
4 in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight. Any member of Missouri Task Force
5 One may annually apply for such license plates.

6 2. Upon presentation of the appropriate proof of eligibility as determined by the
7 director and annual payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee, and
8 other documents which may be required by law, the department of revenue shall issue to
9 the vehicle owner a personalized license plate which shall bear an appropriate
10 configuration to be determined by the director, with the words "MISSOURI TASK
11 FORCE ONE" in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE". Such license plates shall be
12 made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be
13 clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section
14 301.130. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be
15 charged for the personalization of license plates pursuant to this section.

16 3. No more than one set of license plates shall be issued pursuant to this section to
17 a qualified applicant. License plates issued pursuant to this section shall not be
18 transferable to any other person except that any registered co-owner of the motor vehicle

19 shall be entitled to operate the motor vehicle with such plates for the duration of the year
20 licensed in the event of the death of the qualified person. The director of revenue shall
21 make necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this section, and shall
22 design all necessary forms required by this section. No rule or portion of a rule
23 promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section shall become effective unless it has
24 been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.
