AN ACT

To amend chapter 313, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the authority of the lottery commission to authorize new games.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 313, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 313.232, to read as follows:

313.232. 1. After August 28, 2002, the commission shall not implement or operate
2 any keno game unless it is authorized to do so pursuant to statutory authority or approval
3 by the voters of this state.

4 2. For the purposes of this section, "keno" shall mean a game of chance where each
5 player is given one or more sheets that have a panel of numbers from which the player
6 chooses certain numbers by marking his or her selections and placing a bet with a clerk
7 who verifies the numbers the player has chosen. A certain amount of numbers are then
8 chosen at random by the person or persons running the keno game and a player wins by
9 matching his or her selected numbers with the numbers that have been chosen at random.
10 A player is paid according to a schedule of payment provided by the person or persons who
11 are running the game. A keno game may also use video or electronic equipment. Keno
12 shall not include the game of bingo as defined in section 313.005.
