AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to special license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 301.3087, to read as follows:

**301.3087. 1. Any person may receive special license plates as prescribed by this
2 section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an
3 apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen
4 thousand pounds gross weight, after an annual payment of an emblem-use authorization
5 fee to the Animal Friendly License Plate Association. The Animal Friendly License Plate
6 Association hereby authorizes the use of its official emblem to be affixed on multiyear
7 personalized license plates as provided in this section. Any contribution to the Animal
8 Friendly License Plate Association derived from this section, except reasonable
9 administrative costs, shall be used solely for the purposes of the Animal Friendly License
10 Plate Association.**

**11 2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use
12 contribution to the Animal Friendly License Plate Association, the Animal Friendly License
13 Plate Association shall issue to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use
14 authorization statement, which shall be presented by the owner to the department of**

15 revenue at the time of registration of a motor vehicle. Upon presentation of the annual
16 statement, payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee and documents
17 which may be required by law, the department of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner
18 a personalized license plate which shall bear the emblem of the Animal Friendly License
19 Plate Association and shall have the words "ANIMAL FRIENDLY" on the license plates
20 in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE". Such license plates shall be made with fully
21 reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night,
22 and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130.

23 3. A vehicle owner, who was previously issued a plate with the Animal Friendly
24 License Plate Association emblem authorized by this section but who does not provide an
25 emblem-use authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued
26 a new plate which does not bear the Animal Friendly License Plate Association emblem,
27 as otherwise provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and
28 regulations for the administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms
29 required by this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the
30 authority of this section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to
31 the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.
