AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to special license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 301.3084, to read as follows:

**301.3084. 1. Any person may receive special license plates as prescribed by this
2 section, for any motor vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an
3 apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen
4 thousand pounds gross weight, after an annual contribution of an emblem-use
5 authorization fee to the Friends of the Missouri Women's Council. Any contribution to the
6 Friends of the Missouri Women's Council pursuant to this section, except reasonable
7 administrative costs, shall be designated for the sole purpose of providing breast cancer
8 services, including but not limited to screening, treatment, staging, and follow-up services.
9 The Friends of the Missouri Women's Council hereby authorizes the use of its official
10 emblem to be affixed on multiyear personalized license plates as provided in this section.
11 Any person may annually apply for the use of the emblem.**

**12 2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use
13 contribution to the Friends of the Missouri Women's Council, the organization shall issue**

14 to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use authorization statement,
15 which shall be presented by the owner to the department of revenue at the time of
16 registration of a motor vehicle. Upon presentation of the annual statement, payment of a
17 fifteen dollar fee in addition to the registration fee and documents which may be required
18 by law, the department of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a personalized license
19 plate which shall bear a graphic design depicting the breast cancer awareness pink ribbon
20 symbol with the words "Breast Cancer Awareness" forming an oval around the symbol,
21 and shall bear the words "MISSOURI WOMEN'S COUNCIL" in place of the words
22 "SHOW-ME STATE". Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material
23 with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be
24 aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. Notwithstanding the provisions
25 of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license
26 plates pursuant to this section.

27 3. A vehicle owner, who was previously issued a plate with a breast cancer
28 awareness emblem authorized by this section but who does not provide an emblem-use
29 authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new plate
30 which does not bear the emblem, as otherwise provided by law. The director of revenue
31 shall make necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this section, and shall
32 design all necessary forms required by this section. No rule or portion of a rule
33 promulgated pursuant to the authority of this section shall become effective unless it has
34 been promulgated pursuant to the provisions of chapter 536, RSMo.
