

House Resolution No.

Whereas, the Family, Community, and Career Leaders of America (FCCLA) Chapter from Humansville High School in Humansville, Missouri, is to be commended for its efforts to raise more than one thousand dollars for the families of seven firefighters who lost their lives during the September 11 terrorist attacks; and

Whereas, each year, members of the Humansville FCCLA design and make a quilt that is raffled off as a fundraiser to support chapter activities; and

Whereas, the Humansville FCCLA decided to create a quilt that would reflect the attack on New York City as well as the unity of a nation in mourning, and to donate the proceeds of this year's quilt raffle to the September 11 relief fund; and

Whereas, students worked together to gather pieces of red, white, and blue fabric for the quilt, which included a skyline of New York City from checked fabric, an American flag, white doves representing those who lost their lives, and a photo transfer of the Statue of Liberty, and reflected the painstaking effort of the students, teachers, school, community, and country to come together at a time of unprecedented national tragedy; and

Whereas, following an extension in ticket sales, the Humansville FCCLA collected a grand total of \$1,363 that was given to the families of Battalion Chief Matthew Ryan, Captain Thomas Haskell, and Fire Fighters John Viglano, Andrew Jordan, Thomas Mingione, Michael Keifer, and Sergio Dellanueva, all of whom were members of Engine Company 280 in New York City; and
