PROPOSERS: Supporters say that this bill will give Liquor Control the option of closing or imposing a fine on a business that breaks liquor laws. Currently, Liquor Control must close the business. Closing a business effects many individuals, not just the owner. Closing may not be the best option. The bill also allows wholesalers to pick up unused kegs. This will help keep products fresher.
