Currently, persons who plead guilty or are found guilty of driving while intoxicated and driving with excessive blood alcohol content are required to successfully complete a substance abuse traffic offender program, pay the fees required for the program, and pay a supplemental fee of sixty dollars to the Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse within the Department of Mental Health. This bill applies these requirements to persons who plead guilty or who are found guilty of reckless and drunken operation of boats or skis, negligent operation of a vessel, and operating a vessel with excessive blood alcohol content.
