

House Resolution No. 59

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the Grandview C-4 School District in Grandview, Missouri, which has distinguished itself as one of 157 Missouri school districts to be honored for "Distinction in Performance"; and

Whereas, the Grandview C-4 School District was selected for the Distinction in Performance award based on criteria established by the State Board of Education, including MAP and ACT test scores, attendance and drop-out rates, and other academic performance measures; and

Whereas, the Grandview C-4 School District worked with tireless commitment to meet the standards necessary to receive the Distinction in Performance award, which is issued annually and designed to be an incentive for school districts to focus on improving academic achievement; and

Whereas, to qualify for Distinction in Performance this year, K-12 school districts such as Grandview C-4 were required to meet eleven out of twelve possible performance indicators, including all of the standards that are based on the MAP exams; and

Whereas, this prestigious award can lead to tangible benefits for the Grandview schools which can become eligible for "waivers" from some of the state's accreditation procedures if they demonstrate consistent academic progress; and

Whereas, students, teachers, parents, school officials, and members of the Grandview community are exceedingly proud of this well-deserved recognition, which confirms that the Grandview C-4 School District is making steady gains in all areas of academic performance, including test scores; and

Whereas, the State Board of Education will formally recognize the Grandview C-4 School District during a series of meetings across the Show-Me State this Spring:
