

House Resolution No. 223

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State governmental employees who have demonstrated unquestionable courage and astute decision-making abilities when faced with unexpected challenges and situations in life; and

Whereas, Randee Kaiser of Holts Summit, Missouri, is the Assistant Division Director/Medical Services and Acting Division Director for the Division of Offender Rehabilitative Services with the Missouri Department of Corrections; and

Whereas, initially hired by the Missouri Department of Corrections on April 29, 1988, Randee Kaiser has earned distinction for his activities on the Sunday morning of December 8, 2002; and

Whereas, while driving into town to run errands, Randee Kaiser observed a police car with lights flashing turn into the local Lions Club, where a man was lying on the ground with his shirt unbuttoned and surrounded by a crowd of people; and

Whereas, Randee Kaiser unhesitatingly joined the police officer in administering CPR to the unconscious victim who was subsequently transported to the local hospital, where he recovered; and

Whereas, the calm, timely, and skillful intervention by Randee Kaiser in a dangerous situation helped save the life of an upstanding civilian member of the Holts Summit community; and

Whereas, Randee Kaiser will be recognized by the Missouri Department of Corrections on Friday, February 21, 2003, when it grants him a Lifesaver Award for going far beyond his regular duties at great personal risk to help prevent a life-threatening situation; and

Whereas, Randee Kaiser also deserves commendation for his many other successes in life as the beloved husband of Susan Ault Kaiser; father of Randee Miles Kaiser, Jr.; grandfather of Kassidee Kaiser; and holder of a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology, a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing, and a Master of Science degree in psychology:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to salute Randee Kaiser and to convey to him this legislative body's deepest gratitude for his unselfish actions on December 8, 2002, which undoubtedly saved a human life; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in honor of Department of Corrections administrator Randee Kaiser of Holts Summit, Missouri.
