

## House Resolution No. 284

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the Reverend Kenneth F. Haney, formerly of Stockton, California, who enjoys the distinction of serving as General Superintendent of the United Pentecostal Church International, headquartered in Hazelwood, Missouri; and

**Whereas**, Pastor Haney served the congregation at Stockton's Christian Life Center for three decades, during which time he successfully created a close-knit fellowship between members of that exemplary religious institution and the Stockton community; and

**Whereas**, Kenneth Haney accepted the role of pastor at the Christian Life Center in 1972 following the death of his father, Clyde J. Haney, who had been in the pulpit since 1935; and

**Whereas**, Pastor Haney and the congregation of the Christian Life Center merit commendation for their efforts to complete a new church facility on Hammer Lane and expanding the Christian Life College at the West Lane site; and

**Whereas**, Christian Life Center, Stockton Christian School, and Christian Life College owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to Kenneth Haney for the overall commitment he had demonstrated during his longtime in Stockton; and

**Whereas**, Pastor Haney served in the capacity of Assistant General Superintendent for six years before being elected General Superintendent of the United Pentecostal Church International on October 10, 2001, at the United Pentecostal Church General Conference in Louisville, Kentucky, where he continues to serve with distinction; and

**Whereas**, Pastor Haney has been abundantly blessed with the love and admiration of a wonderful family whose members include his devoted wife of forty years, Joy, an international speaker and author of forty-two books, and his five children and seven grandchildren:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously in expressing appreciation to Pastor Haney for his thirty years of commitment to the faithful at the Stockton Christian Life Center and in extending best wishes for continued success and fulfillment in his current responsibility of leadership as General Superintendent of the United Pentecostal Church International; and
