

House Resolution No. 519

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those individuals who have brought glory and honor to themselves and to the Show-Me State because of the excellent nature of their career-long achievements; and

Whereas, Howard C. Jones of Winston-Salem, North Carolina, has attained distinction as a 1969 graduate of Liberty High School, where he excelled in his studies; and

Whereas, a theater set designer of national renown, Howard Jones will be recognized during a three-day-long celebratory event sponsored by the Liberty School District Foundation which will include a fund-raising dessert reception, a dinner, and several meetings and classroom interactions with local students; and

Whereas, Howard Jones has designed stage sets for a wide variety of organizations, including the Starlight Theatre, Missouri Repertory Theatre, and American Heartland Theatre, and for theater companies in Boston and other east-coast cities; and

Whereas, holder of a Best of Theater Award in Kansas City for his set design for the 1940's Radio Hour, Howard Jones is the son of Bob and Nancy Jones and a William Jewell College graduate who has been active in volunteering his services to his alma mater and in sharing his considerable skills as a scenic artist with young people who are learning the profession; and

Whereas, the Liberty School District Foundation was organized in 1995 as a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation to support the people and programs of Liberty public schools in a growing concern which aims to help students and teachers through Hope Awards, Learning Enrichment Grants, and Senior Scholarships:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the exemplary career achievements garnered by Howard Jones since his graduation from Liberty High School in 1969 and to convey to him this legislative body's heartiest congratulations and best wishes upon his selection for a Honoring Our Own Alumni Award from the Liberty School District Foundation; and
