Whereas, Mallory Glosier is very involved in her church's youth group, with which she attended a mission trip to Mexico to build houses for needy families during the summer of 2002; and

Whereas, Mallory Glosier served as Mayor and Recreational Director at Girls State, was named "Student of the Month" for September 2002, and qualified for a Bright Flight scholarship on the basis of her ACT scores; and

Whereas, Mallory Glosier plans to major in communications and minor in psychology as an undergraduate and then attend law school to pursue her interest in politics:
