

## House Resolution No. 829

**Whereas**, the Missouri House of Representatives proudly salutes the members of the Missouri Army National Guard 203rd Engineer Combat Battalion (Heavy) located in Joplin, Neosho, Springfield, Anderson, Clinton, St. Peters, Carthage, Monett, Pierce City, and Fort Leonard Wood, who have been mobilized to support Operation Enduring Freedom; and

**Whereas**, the 203rd Engineer Combat Battalion can trace its history back to Missouri volunteer militia units that formed in 1883, while the militia units in southwest Missouri were reorganized into the 2nd Infantry Regiment of the National Guard of Missouri in 1890 and mustered into federal service during the Spanish-American War; and

**Whereas**, the 2nd Missouri Infantry was called up to serve during the Mexican border dispute in 1916; redesignated as 128th, 129th, and 130th machine gun battalions in 1917; transformed into the 203rd Artillery, Coast Artillery Corps in 1921; inducted into federal service in September of 1940; and was later sent to Alaska for the Aleutian Campaign; and

**Whereas**, in 1963, the unit was redesignated 1st Battalion, 203rd Armor, and became an engineer battalion following reorganization in 1968, since which time it has remained an engineer battalion; and

**Whereas**, Company C, 203rd, is based in Monett with Detachment 1 in Pierce City, and is commanded by Captain Gerald Green and 1st Sergeant Randall Mackey; and

**Whereas**, Company C will attend departing ceremonies in Pierce City and Monett on March 18, 2003, before leaving for Fort Leonard Wood; and

**Whereas**, in a time of uncertainty, it is comforting to know that there are dedicated individuals such as the members of the 203rd Engineer Combat Battalion, Company C, who will fight for the rights and freedom of all Americans through their selfless acts of courage and their firm belief in liberty and justice for all:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in expressing our utmost appreciation to the members and leaders of Missouri Army National Guard 203rd Engineer Combat Battalion, Company C, as they depart the great state of Missouri and embark upon an unknown journey in which they will strive to make the world a better and safer place for all mankind; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the members of the Missouri Army National Guard 203rd Engineer Combat Battalion, Company C.
