

House Resolution No. 847

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to acknowledge milestone attainments in the lives and careers of Show-Me State labor leaders who have admirably dedicated themselves to protecting the rights and opportunities of working men and women; and

Whereas, Frank Quinn has developed and maintained an exceptional reputation as the Business Manager for Pipefitters' Local 533, in which capacity he has earned considerable praise as one of the most respected leaders in the Labor Community; and

Whereas, Frank Quinn has enjoyed the loyal support of many individuals, including the Honorable Jenée Lowe, State Representative from District Number 44, who has valued his friendship for more than twenty years and has appreciated his leadership of her Local 533; and

Whereas, Frank Quinn has been selected by Labor's Educational and Political Club Independent (LEPCI) to receive the "Labor's Representative of the Year for 2003" award which is given to those who preserve the hard-earned rights of this nation's working men and women:
