Whereas, the fourteen-year-old son of Brad and Margie LaMore, Adam distinguished himself as the only Missourian and as one of only six individuals to make a perfect score among those who took the test in December 2002; and

Whereas, Adam LaMore took the ACT the first time for a talent search three years ago at the age of eleven and scored a 28, which was well above the national average of 21; and

Whereas, Adam LaMore attended kindergarten through third grade in the Fox School District and then transferred to the Lindbergh School District to be part of the Program for Exceptionally Gifted Students (PEGS); and

Whereas, following his fifth grade at Truman Elementary School, Adam LaMore skipped sixth and seventh grades and spent one year at Sperreng Middle School as an eleven-year-old eighth-grader; and

Whereas, with plans for an International Baccalaureate diploma, Adam is enrolled in all Honors classes, but also makes time to socialize and plays in the school band as a percussionist who was named Section Leader of "the pit" last fall; and

Whereas, America takes special pride in young people like Adam LaMore who show great promise in meeting the challenges that tomorrow has to offer:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously in extending our most hearty congratulations to Adam LaMore at this proud moment of scholastic achievement and in wishing him only the best in all future endeavors; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Outstanding Missourian Adam LaMore, as a measure of our esteem for him.
