

## House Resolution No. 1395

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the important role that this state's public schools play in the educational development of countless young Missouri citizens; and

**Whereas**, Eugene Field Elementary School in the St. Joseph School District has distinguished itself as one of 226 public schools in 140 Missouri school districts to earn the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education "Top 10" honors; and

**Whereas**, Eugene Field Elementary School achieved Top 10 status based on its students' consistently high scores in one or more areas of the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) examinations; and

**Whereas**, this marks the fourth time that Eugene Field Elementary School has appeared in the Top 10 honors program, which was established in 1999; and

**Whereas**, the Department's annual list of highest-performing schools identifies elementary, middle, and secondary schools with the highest percentages of students scoring at the "Proficient" and "Advanced" levels in each subject area and grade level covered by the mandatory MAP tests; and

**Whereas**, the purpose of the report is to recognize students and teachers in high-performing buildings and to identify successful schools such as Eugene Field Elementary School that can provide effective examples of ways to improve student achievement; and

**Whereas**, being listed among the state's ten top-performing schools in a particular subject and grade level is something about which students, teachers, and staff at Eugene Field Elementary School can be proud:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in extending our most hearty congratulations and best wishes to Eugene Field Elementary School and the St. Joseph School District at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Eugene Field Elementary School in St. Joseph, Missouri.
