

House Resolution No. 1269

Whereas, the Missouri League for Nursing has successfully initiated Leadership Institutes for nursing students, nurse managers, and nurse educators that assist in developing nursing leaders who solve the problems in today's health care arena with excellence; and

Whereas, the Missouri League for Nursing funds and administers three scholarship funds to provide assistance to the future nurses of Missouri:
