Whereas, astutely run by Allen Tatman, Paddy Malone's Pub is the latest incarnation of a very short list of establishments which have made 700 West Main Street their home; and

Whereas, constructed in 1863, the structure housing Paddy Malone's Pub first went by the moniker of West End Saloon, which then became First Chance Last Chance, and then Pat's Place; and

Whereas, proprietor Allen Tatman has worked hard to promote an atmosphere at Paddy Malone's Pub that is truly unique to the Jefferson City community, which enjoys a stellar role as the centrally-located state capital; and

Whereas, Paddy Malone's Pub lies just a few short blocks from the imposing west-facing facade of the Missouri capitol with its steep stairs and columned walls supporting a stately dome crowned by a statue of Ceres, the Roman goddess of agriculture; and

Whereas, just as imposing in its own special way with a red-brick exterior and well-worn stone front step, Paddy Malone's Pub proudly stands as the Irish Cultural Center of Jefferson City and the surrounding environs:
