**Whereas**, on Tuesday, April 15, 2003, Billy Skaggs will meet with state legislators in the Missouri House of Representatives to receive well-deserved honors and accolades for the exemplary role he has performed in the Kansas City area as a politician, community leader and activist, and current member of the Kansas City Council:
