Whereas, St. Charles Police Captain Pat McCarrick deserves commendation for his well-deserved selection to receive the 2002 St. Charles Crime Stoppers Law Enforcement Officer of the Year award which will be presented to him on Thursday, April 24, 2003, at the Eleventh Annual Community Recognition Dinner at The Columns Banquet Center; and

Whereas, it is through the actions of professionals such as Captain Pat McCarrick that society is made safer and the criminal element is called to task for preying on the vast majority of an area's residents who are law-abiding and peaceful:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the selection of Captain Pat McCarrick for the 2002 St. Charles Crime Stoppers Law Enforcement Officer of the Year award and to convey to him this legislative body's most heartfelt commendation of his willingness to intervene on behalf of others in dangerous circumstances; and
