

## House Resolution No. 2057

**Whereas**, it is with great pleasure that the members of the Missouri House of Representatives pause to recognize the meritorious achievements of an outstanding young Missouri citizen who has distinguished himself through excellence in athletics; and

**Whereas**, Mexico Bulldog Senior Guard Sean Raboin has earned Second-Team Honors in Class 4 High School Basketball because of his unbelievable talent and success; and

**Whereas**, chosen to the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association initial All-State Team, Sean Raboin paced Mexico with 596 points and 311 rebounds, averaging 21.3 ppg and 11.1rpg; and

**Whereas**, Sean Raboin shot 46.8 percent from the field, second only to senior teammate Dustin Shoemaker among the starters, including 37.1 percent from 3-point range, making a team-high 43 shots from beyond the arc; and

**Whereas**, Sean Raboin converted 137 of 195 foul shots for 70.3 percent, third-best among the Bulldog regulars by just a fraction of a point, while pulling down 120 offensive rebounds and totaling 86 assists/34 steals, all top team totals; and

**Whereas**, Sean Raboin opened the season pumping in 28 points and netted a season-high 34 on January 21, 2003, against Warrenton, following that up with 32 on January 25 against Hannibal; and

**Whereas**, Sean Raboin reached double figures 27 times in Mexico's 18-10/4-3 campaign, falling short with 8 points January 28 against Jefferson City, but hitting 20 or more points 16 times and 30 or more 4 times; and

**Whereas**, Sean Raboin finished his Mexico High School career with 1,012 for the Bulldogs and 1,160 overall:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously in extending our most hearty and robust congratulations to Sean Raboin as he enjoys the distinction of this high honor and in wishing him continued success in meeting the challenges of tomorrow; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Sean Raboin, as a measure of our esteem for him.
