

## House Resolution No. 2710

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives enjoy a long, proud tradition of meeting their responsibilities to the citizens of this state while upholding the virtues represented by the "Glory of Missouri": Knowledge, Liberty, Equality, Law, Justice, Fraternity, Education, Progress, Honor, Truth, Virtue, Temperance, Enterprise, and Charity; and

**Whereas**, these virtues are engraved in the House Chamber of the State Capitol with the inscription: "All the foregoing human qualities bind into one theme, the Glory of Missouri, because no people attain these virtues unless they are great."; and

**Whereas**, the "Glory of Missouri" virtues were engraved in the early 1920s under the direction of the Decorating Commission, which recognized their relevance and importance to the early Missouri Legislature; and

**Whereas**, the "Glory of Missouri" Award was created to encourage the values held by the early leaders of Missouri and to recognize those standards as exemplified in our schools and communities by this state's young people, the future of Missouri; and

**Whereas**, Mike Robins, a student in the Woodland R-IV School District in Marble Hill, has been selected to receive the "Glory of Missouri" Award for his accomplishments in the area of TEMPERANCE as defined by Webster's dictionary in 1926: "Moderation of passion, self-control; calmness. Habitual moderation in the indulgence of the appetites and passions; moderation.";

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join in commending Mike Robins for his noteworthy achievements in the pursuit of "TEMPERANCE", and in extending heartfelt congratulations to him at this proud moment of well-deserved distinction; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Mike Robins, as a measure of our esteem for him.
