

House Resolution No. 2663

Whereas, KJLU, 88.9 FM radio station at Lincoln University in Jefferson City, Missouri, is a 29,500 watt stereo FM station licensed to the Board of Curators of Lincoln University that has served mid-Missouri since 1973; and

Whereas, KJLU-FM broadcasts more than seventy-five hours of jazz each week in a mix that includes straight ahead, swing, bop, funk, fusion, and contemporary styles from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Monday-Friday, and weekends; and

Whereas, KJLU-FM also broadcasts more than fifty hours of urban hits, including Quiet Storm, club, hip-hop, rap, R&B, and classic soul styles on evenings and weekends; and

Whereas, KJLU-FM serves approximately 195,190 people in ten central Missouri counties covered by its one milivolt contour; and

Whereas, KJLU was recognized as the 2002-2003 Black College Radio Station of the Year at the 25th Annual Black College Radio Conference held April 11-12, 2003, in Atlanta, Georgia, during which the station was honored for its superb music, news, and informational programming, while three station employees were honored as finalists for awards, including Mike Downey, Station Manager of the Year; David Owens, Program Director; and K-Tone, On Air Personality:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in extending our most hearty congratulations to all those dedicated individuals affiliated with KJLU-FM for their efforts in making KJLU the 2002-2003 Black College Radio Station of the Year, and in wishing them much success as they continue to provide their listeners with exceptional music, news, and informational broadcasting; and
