

## House Resolution No. 2932

**Whereas**, for the past forty-three years, Rosary High School in Spanish Lake has distinguished itself as a place where Catholic values and preparation for the future have had a major influence on the lives of thousands of St. Louis students; and

**Whereas**, Rosary High School is a co-educational, Archdiocesan high school that has fostered spiritual, physical, social, and moral growth while promoting scholarship, creativity, and personal initiative among its students; and

**Whereas**, the School Sisters of Notre Dame began providing a rich, faith-based education with just 196 students and 12 faculty members in 1961, since which time more than 9,000 students have graduated from Rosary High School with strong Catholic values and an excellent secondary education; and

**Whereas**, throughout its rich history, Rosary High School has remained a fully-accredited, St. Louis Archdiocesan high school committed to excellence in education which has also provided as many as thirty-one extracurricular activities each school year that include sports, clubs and organizations, a school newspaper, drama, yearbook, and KRHS radio; and

**Whereas**, eight state championships have been won by sports teams at Rosary High School along with numerous other conference and district titles, while academic championships have also fared well; and

**Whereas**, an active campus ministry has offered a variety of avenues for students and faculty to grow deeper in faith and in Christian service to the community; and

**Whereas**, since its humble beginning more than four decades ago, Rosary High School has grown and developed into a quality place of learning and a well-respected institution in North St. Louis County:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in a thunderous round of applause for Rosary High School in appreciation of the achievements it has realized through forty-three years of commendable service to the young citizens of the St. Louis community; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in honor of Rosary High School.
