

## House Resolution No. 3135

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in tremendous esteem those young Show-Me State residents who have bettered themselves and their communities through the challenges and opportunities available to them in the Boy Scouts of America program; and

**Whereas**, Jayson Alan Fulmer of Troop 391 entered Scouting eight years ago, since which time he has excelled in innumerable ways while maturing as a person and as a citizen; and

**Whereas**, Jayson progressed on his illustrious sojourn by completing all of the requirements for the Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life ranks and by serving his Troop in such leadership posts as Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Den Chief, and Instructor; and

**Whereas**, Jayson is a Foxman in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say who has attended three sessions at H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation, earned thirty-nine merit badges, garnered the Mile Swim patch, qualified for the Totin' Chip and Firem'n Chit, learned snorkeling, and received the Paul Bunyan, Ad Altare Dei, Den Chief, World Conservation, Twelve Month Camper, Don Boscoe, and Cub Scout Arrow of Light awards; and
