

House Resolution No. 101

Whereas, Daniel Alan "Danny" White, a resident of Kansas City, Missouri, will receive the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor ceremony to be held on January 25, 2004, at St. Peter's Episcopal Church; and

Whereas, Danny, a member of Boy Scout Troop 46, successfully met the requirements to attain Eagle status by completing his Eagle project which involved making a cross-shaped garden for the children in the daycare program at St. Peter's Episcopal Church; and

Whereas, during his ten years in Scouting, Danny mastered several challenging and diverse skills to earn thirty-five merit badges, two Fifty-Miler awards, the Coup of the Long Trail, the World Conservation Award, and the status of Tom-Tom Beater in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say, where he has taken the tribal name Eldest Son of White Burning Cedar; and

Whereas, Danny demonstrated his capability and willingness to exert leadership by fulfilling the duties and responsibilities of Assistant Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, Chaplain Aide, Historian, Troop Guide, and Instructor; and

Whereas, the son of David and Dianne White, and the brother of Boy Scout Dick White, Danny developed immense personal growth and fitness by participating in the many assorted activities the Boy Scouts offers, some of which include attending H. Roe Bartle Scout Reservation for six years, camping 135 nights, volunteering 86 hours of community service, and going on High Adventure trips to Philmont and the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness; and

Whereas, Danny's attainment of the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that required considerable dedication and effort:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously in extending our most hearty congratulations to Danny White for the steadfast determination he displayed in his pursuit to attain the rank of Eagle and in wishing him continued success in all future endeavors; and
