Whereas, Missouri Governor Bob Holden and First Lady Lori Hauser Holden will present Kenneth Kranzberg with the 2004 Missouri Arts Award during a special awards ceremony to be held February 11, 2004, in the Rotunda of the Missouri State Capitol:
