Whereas, Bob Shore has attained considerable distinction as the head football coach for the Camdenton High School Lakers, an extracurricular pursuit which he has undertaken for twenty-nine years; and

Whereas, in February 2004 coach Bob Shore will enhance his already stellar record of athletic achievement when he is inducted with thirteen others into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2004; and

Whereas, coach Bob Shore has earned 303 career wins and prior induction into the Missouri Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame; and

Whereas, a standout football and basketball player at Cassville High School, Bob Shore continued his education at Joplin Junior College, Pittsburg State University in Pittsburg, Kansas, and Drury University, where he earned his Master in Education degree; and

Whereas, Bob Shore began his coaching career at Seneca before leading teams at Jasper and East Newman High School near Granby; and

Whereas, during his lengthy coaching career, Bob Shore has guided Lakers teams to an average of nine wins per season and a total of twenty district championships, five state quarterfinals, three state semifinals, two state runners-up, and four state championships; and

Whereas, coach Bob Shore also produced fifty-nine all-state players, a host of players who have played college ball and gone into coaching as a career, and one player, Jason Whittle, who plays professional football for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers; and

Whereas, coach Bob Shore is the beloved husband of Marilyn, the loving father of Jeff and Jenny, the father-in-law of Stacy, and the grandfather of Sophie and Bo with Barrett well on his way:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the well-deserved selection of football coach Bob Shore for induction into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and to convey to him this legislative body's heartiest commendation of his long, productive, ongoing educational career; and
