Whereas, the son of David and Laurie Kraft, Kyle developed immense personal growth and fitness by participating in the many assorted activities the Boy Scouts offers, some of which include attending summer camp for six years, completing Junior Leader Training, and going on two High Adventure trips to Philmont; and

Whereas, Kyle's attainment of the Eagle rank will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that required considerable dedication and effort:
