**Whereas**, the Ladue School District is losing a valuable member of its faculty with the resignation of Superintendent of Schools Dr. Stewart Weinberg, who is stepping down to assume the responsibilities of Superintendent of Schools in Dallastown, Pennsylvania; and

**Whereas**, Dr. Weinberg has served four years as Superintendent in the Ladue School District, where he is held in high esteem for his overall competence and successful leadership; and

**Whereas**, deeply committed to the great cause of learning, Dr. Weinberg served as Superintendent of Schools for the North Star Borough School District in Fairbanks, Alaska, and the Lawrence School District in New York before transferring to the Ladue School District; and

**Whereas**, during his four-year tenure in the Ladue School District, Dr. Weinberg has reduced class sizes, implemented a foreign language program in the elementary schools, has begun developing individual learning plans for each student, and placed an emphasis on eliminating the African-American achievement gap; and

**Whereas**, Stewart Weinberg, who earned a Doctorate and Master's degree at New York University in New York City, has been involved in numerous local and regional organizations, including the Creve Coeur-Olivette Chamber of Commerce, the Jewish Federation of St. Louis, FOCUS-St. Louis, and the local chapter of the National Conference for Community and Justice; and

**Whereas**, Stewart Weinberg has been blessed with the love and support of a wonderful family whose members include his wife, Margaret Weinberg, an artist and teacher; two sons and their wives, Justin and Sara Weinberg and Benjamin and Amy Weinberg; and one grandchild, Milo:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join the Ladue School District in expressing appreciation for the unparalleled service that Stewart Weinberg has rendered to Missouri's children and in wishing him continued success in all future endeavors; and
