Whereas, Brian Hauswirth started with Premier Marketing Group as the News Director of KFRU in Columbia in February 1998, and has served as KLIK's News Director since July 2000; and

Whereas, Brian Hauswirth also served as KLIK's News Director from November 1995 to February 1998, when he first joined the Premier Marketing Group; and

Whereas, the voice of Jefferson City Jays football and basketball, Brian Hauswirth also hosts Party Line on weekday mornings and serves as a college football scoreboard host for Learfield Sports in Jefferson City; and

Whereas, in 1998, Brian Hauswirth won the Associated Press Missouri Small Market Radio Spot News Award for his live coverage of a Columbia tornado, and won the same award again in 1999 for his on-the-scene reporting of a fatal fire on the University of Missouri-Columbia campus; and

Whereas, Brian Hauswirth and KLIK also received awards for their coverage of Governor Mel Carnahan's Memorial Service in 2000, and for the last day of the 2001 Legislative Session:
