Whereas, Jessica Fraser's other important affiliations include the Women's Issues Network and Habitat for Humanity, for which she managed and organized the 200-member UNC Campus Chapter, organized and led weekly steering committee meetings, and helped construct homes in New Jersey, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, and the Honduras:
