Whereas, Linda Goldstein is responsible for sales, finance, and operations for a branch that is consistently ranked among the top locations nationally and provides approximately 100 jobs at the local level; and

Whereas, in April 2002, Linda Goldstein was elected to her second term as Ward II Alderman in the City of Clayton, where she serves on a number of commissions including the Center of Clayton's governing board, a partnership between the City and the Clayton School District; and

Whereas, selected as one of the 25 Most Influential Women in Business in St. Louis in 2002 by the St. Louis Business Journal, Linda Goldstein is a native of Chicago who earned her Bachelor's degree in Public Relations from the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana and her Master's degree in Counseling Psychology from Saint Louis University:
