

House Resolution No.

Whereas, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives hold in high esteem those Show-Me State residents who have admirably assisted state, county, and local governments in providing much-needed services and programs in the efficient, effective manner mandated by the public; and

Whereas, Robert “Bob” Perry of Columbia has attained considerable distinction since accepting the diverse duties and responsibilities of Boone County Court Administrator in October 1972; and

Whereas, the Court Administrator for more than three decades, Bob Perry will draw his vocational leadership to a close in June 2004 in retirement; and

Whereas, Bob Perry was selected for his role as Court Administrator by a committee of circuit court judges with the presiding judge serving as chairman; and

Whereas, down through the years Bob Perry has worked with a number of county commissioners and has played a part in many job improvements, particularly those related to juvenile detention; and

Whereas, Bob Perry is overseeing a 2004 court budget that calls for expenditures projected at \$2.52 million--an approximately 1.4 percent decrease from the previous year--and anticipated revenue from state reimbursement and court fees totaling \$596,423--a 0.7 percent increase compared to 2003; and

Whereas, Bob Perry will ensure a balanced budget by getting from the county’s budget the difference between expected expenditures and projected state contributions; and

Whereas, other recent accomplishments by Court Administrator Bob Perry are the expanded juvenile center scheduled to open in October 2004 and an increase in interpreting services to match the growth of the area’s Hispanic population:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud Robert Perry’s personal and career accomplishments during the past thirty-two years and to convey to him this legislative body’s heartiest congratulations and our best wishes as he partakes of the special opportunities and pleasures traditionally associated with the golden years of retirement; and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution in honor of Robert Perry of Columbia, Missouri.
