

## House Resolution No. 3277

**Whereas**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives always welcome the opportunity to recognize young men who have excelled during their association with the Boy Scouts of America program with its emphasis on physical, mental, and spiritual growth; self-reliance; personal values; service to others; and an appreciation and understanding of the wonderful natural world; and

**Whereas**, Daniel Holland of Troop 620 has successfully completed all of the stringent requirements for Scouting's highest advancement award, the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be bestowed upon him during an Eagle Court of Honor on Wednesday, June 30, 2004, at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in Springfield; and

**Whereas**, attainment of the Eagle Scout rank is dependent upon the sequential completion of each of the Boy Scout steps of Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life, and expected troop service, a requirement admirably fulfilled by Daniel through the billets of Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, and Assistant Patrol Leader; and

**Whereas**, diligent labors by Daniel earned him induction into the Order of the Arrow; Arrow of Light, Faith in God, and Fifty Miler awards; and twenty-two Merit Badges which are arrayed on his uniform sash as a visual illustration of the diverse skills and knowledge which he has acquired as a Boy Scout; and

**Whereas**, in keeping with Scouting practice, Daniel applied the knowledge which he learned at troop meetings in many camping, hiking, and service activities, including a trek through Philmont Scout Ranch and three trips to Arrowhead; and

**Whereas**, Daniel completed an Eagle Project which consisted of preparing the Ozark High School Library for the move into its new building, an endeavor which involved enlisting volunteers and coordinating efforts to pack approximately ten thousand books, videos, and periodicals and which also resulted in his donating one hundred extra taped boxes for teachers to use in their classrooms:

**Now, therefore, be it resolved** that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, join unanimously to applaud the outstanding achievements realized by Daniel Holland during his eight-year-long sojourn with Scouting and to congratulate him for having the drive and energy necessary to attain the rank of Eagle; and

**Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for new Eagle Scout Daniel Holland, beloved son of Bob and Jamie Holland of Ozark, Missouri.
