Whereas, these individuals placed themselves in harm's way, risking their own personal safety to protect the lives of others; and

Whereas, the value of the security and peace of mind they provided was truly beyond measure; and

Whereas, the Department of the Army has ordered to active duty the members of the 139th Medical Group, who will report to their mobilization station at Camp Atterbury, Indiana, to provide support for Operation Enduring Freedom (KFOR 6A); and

Whereas, the mission of the 139th Medical Group is to provide command and control to its assigned area; and

Whereas, in a time of uncertainty, it is comforting to know that there are dedicated individuals such as the members of the 139th Medical Group who will fight for the rights and freedom of all Americans through their selfless acts of courage and their firm belief in liberty and justice for all; and

Whereas, on Friday, June 11, 2004, the Honorable Ray Salva, State Representative of the 51st Legislative District, will present the 139th Medical Group with a flag that was flown over the State Capitol of Missouri; and

Whereas, it is entirely fitting and proper that this legislative body should pay tribute to all those dedicated men and women who serve in active duty:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives, Ninety-second General Assembly, unanimously join in expressing our utmost appreciation to the members and leaders of the 139th Medical Group as they mobilize for active duty connected with Operation Enduring Freedom (KFOR 6A); and

Be it further resolved that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the 139th Medical Group of Independence, Missouri.
