Whereas, Chris demonstrated his capability and willingness to exert leadership by fulfilling the duties and responsibilities of Patrol Leader, Librarian, Historian, and Troop Guide; and

Whereas, the son of Jack and Connie Weber, Chris developed immense personal growth and fitness by participating in the many assorted activities the Boy Scouts offers, some of which include working on staff at the Osage Hills Day Camp, completing Junior Leader Training, being a member of the Junior USA Shooting Team, hiking 225 miles on the Katy Trail, attending Camp Arrowhead, visiting the National Scouting Museum, taking part in the Scout Band and Jamboree on the Air, and going on a High Adventure trip to Philmont; and

Whereas, attainment of the Eagle rank by Chris will be recognized at all levels of our society as being a great achievement that required considerable dedication and effort:
